Come and Join with local school children, EcoQuest students, DOC Rangers, Fonterra Farmers, and other community members for a fun morning of planting trees and caring for our future.

Bring friends and family and enjoy a well-earned sausage sizzle for lunch.

We will be planting at Rangipo, a wetland reserve being established right beside the road 2.5km south of Kaihua and just south of Rangipo Road. This wetland contains some rare plants, and provides a home for eels and native fish. The restoration is a 5-year project which was started in 2013. So far 1800 plants have been planted. People will be able to enjoy watching these grow and develop each time they pass by.

Planting will kick off at 9am and we will wind up at lunch time.

Wear sturdy foot wear (gumboots may be good as it can be wet!) and come prepared with warm clothes and sunscreen – we will be there rain or shine!

Spades will be provided.
