What to bring

Please come prepared for changeable weather conditions and ensure you have sufficient warm clothing, raincoat, hats, etc and wear appropriate footwear (ie. closed shoes, comfortable for walking in). Remember Rangitoto is a 30-minute journey from the city, so please bring any important medications you may need.

Walking distance

Travel from Islington Bay wharf to the Islington Bay Hall for the ceremony will involve a walk of approximately 200 metres over uneven, gently inclining ground. Please advise if you have mobility issues so we may organise shuttle transport for your comfort.

Bio-security reminder

Rangitoto and Motutapu are pest-free sanctuaries. We appreciate your efforts to ensure that your footwear is clean (soil and seed free) and that you check your bag for pests (rodents, ants, skinks, soil and seeds) prior to boarding the ferry. Please ensure all bags are secure – no open bags (zips essential). A bio-security ranger and a specially trained conservation dog will be stationed at the pier to inspect all gear prior to boarding the vessel.
